



Michael Herzog is the CEO of nexB. nexB provides products and services to help companies actively identify and manage their software assets, including open source, third-party/commercial and original components so that these companies can gain the benefits of an integrated software supply chain. nexB is currently best known for expert analysis of software provenance (origin and license) offered for software acquisition due diligence and for software product release management. Michael and his nexB co-founder, Philippe Ombredanne, were the original architects of a standard format for exchanging software package data, now known as SPDX (www.spdx.org).

Michael has over twenty-five years of experience in the enterprise software industry including executive and management roles in strategy, product management, marketing, engineering and consulting. He gained that experience at companies including Xoriant, KPMG Consulting (Bearingpoint), Oracle and Walker Interactive. At KPMG, Michael was the partner in charge of the Oracle practice, growing it from \$50M to \$500M in five years. At Oracle, he designed many of the original Oracle Financials and CRM business applications and launched the Oracle Projects suite.
